ABSTRACT

This Thesis is focused on the study of the Law on the Artificial Gun Weapon Control which is stipulated under Gun, Ammunition, Explosive Substance, Firework and Artificial Gun Weapon Act, B. E. 2490 (A. D. 1947), with respect to some problems on the artificial gun weapons, the meaning of the artificial gun weapons, the possessions of the artificial gun weapons, the applications for Permits to possess, utilize, carry the artificial gun weapons and the suitability on the Penalty Provision in order to conform with the present social situation.

Result of the study finds that the enforcement on Gun, Ammunition, Explosive Substance, Firework and Artificial Gun Weapon Act, B. E. 2490 has not thoroughly covered the artificial gun weapons on the matters of the possessions, the applications for Permits to possess, utilize, carry the artificial gun weapons, thus, making the possessions of the artificial gun weapons or carrying the artificial gun weapons into the public places somewhat easily without any difficulty. Some artificial gun weapons are dangerous and seriously harmful to the persons, it is, therefore, expedient that statutory provisions should be clearly prescribed as a control measure as those of the guns by stipulating the qualifications of persons to be entitled to possess the artificial gun weapons; giving the definition of the word "Artificial Gun Weapon" which is dangerous and needed to be controlled by each category including the stipulation on muzzle velocity in order that the Penalty Provision and the matters with respect to the possessions, utilizations and carrying of the artificial gun weapons can be stipulated and that the permission thereof be compellingly required as the same as those of the guns by adopting the steps on an application for a permission to possess, utilize and carry a gun for the purpose of such application.

Based on the problems which have been arisen, I, as the Researcher, would like to recommend that the Law on Gun, Ammunition, Explosive Substance, Firework and Artificial Gun Weapon Act, B. E. 2490, be amended, by initiating actions through the Legislative Body in order that the Law can be scrutinized and Ministerial Regulations additionally issued in stipulating details on the Artificial Gun Weapons. In order to back up the artificial gun weapon development, the objectives on having in possession, utilizations, carrying of an artificial gun weapon, of a person or an organization and heavier penalty by duration of the prison term to be longer than that of the gun-related offence should be stipulated in order that the control over the artificial gun weapons can be efficiently achieved.
