ABSTRACT

The objective of the research is to create a model law on dispute resolution in criminal justice procedure. Due to a large number of criminal disputes Affecting the entire criminal justice system To reduce the number of cases to court Reduce conflicts Reconciliation in society Reduce the national budget And strengthen the society to live together in a normal, happy way Therefore lead to the preparation of the original law on Settlement of disputes in the criminal justice process To define as a central law for government agencies inquiry official Public prosecutor Court with the power to consider criminal cases Or the center for civil dispute resolution Used to suppress certain types of criminal disputes By analyzing internal laws Foreign law international law and Research methodology is Qualitative research consisting of Documentary research; In-depth interviews; Participatory Design, Co- Design; and Hearing. Resulting in a method for resolving disputes that can reduce criminal cases at all stages of the criminal justice system The structure of model law consisting of Mediation; Suspension of prosecution; No prosecution to non-public interest; Plea-bargaining, which will lead to the amendment of the Mediation Dispute Act BE 2562.

Draft Act Settlement of disputes in the criminal justice process B.E. Which has been prepared Consisting of provisions Number 67 Divided into 5 categories As follows: Category 1 Mediation Category 2 Prohibition Category 3 Order not to prosecute cases that are not beneficial to the public Category 4 Negotiating Confessions Category 5 Penalty And transitional provisions

Research recommended that the Model Law of this research should be utilized for the amendment of the Mediation Dispute Act BE 2562. Further research are “Model Law on Promoting Mediation Disputes Resolution in the Community” and “Laws on Civil Dispute Resolution”.
