ABSTRACT

The objective of the research is to formulate the principles of good governance for co-operative. Research methodology was Qualitative Research consisting of documentary research; in-depth interview; participatory design, co-design; and hearing. The analysis is descriptive analysis.

The research found out that principles of good governance appropriated to the management system for cooperation is “Corporative Good Governance” consisting of 7 principles including 1. Rule of Law; 2. Morality and Ethics; 3. Transparency and Disclosure; 4. Participation and Consensus Orientation; 5. Equity; 6. Accountability; and 7. Effectiveness and Efficiency. The principles can be divided into three groups i.e., Legal Governance consisting of principle of Rule of Law. Ethical Governance consisting of principles of Morality and Ethics; Transparency and Disclosure; Participation and Consensus Orientation. Philanthropic Governance consisting of principles of Equality; Accountability; and Effectiveness and Efficiency.

The research suggested that all types of co-operatives including the Co-operative Promotion Department and the Co-operative Auditing Department should apply the seven Co-operative Good Governance principles to be the guideline for management and assessment of the implementation. Then develop to be enforced by issuing Ministerial Regulation to be implemented by Saving Co-operative and Credit Union Co-operative. Other types of co-operative should rely on the authority of Co-operative Registrar to issue Order under the Cooperatives Act B.E. 2542. Further research titles are “The development

of Co-operative Model as to the objectives of the target” or “Law Model which accord with the management of each type of Co-operative”.
