ABSTRACT

The objective of this research is to organize accommodation of non-hotel and dormitory in order to meet minimum standards of operation; management; and services for the orderliness of the community, society, Economy, Crime Prevention, hygiene and environmental protection, Consumer rights and to promote the image of tourism. Research methodology is qualitative research consisting of documentary research; in-depth interviews; participatory design, co-design; and hearing in order to formulate a model law on Organize non-hotel accommodation and dormitory.

The research findings are the formulation of a model law for the controlling and supervising the the accommodation entrepreneur. A draft bill on the organizing of accommodation that is a non-hotel and dormitory, B.E., with a legal structure of 35 sections consisting of Definition; Controlling Agency; Promotion and Supervising Committee on business of accommodation; Notification and request for business operation permission; Management to prevent problems; Entrepreneur's Liability; and the participation of people.

The research suggests to enact this law in order to organize and control accommodation that is non-hotel and dormitory. Issue a Byelaw for the enforcement.
