ABSTRACT

The objective of the research is to find results in management, promotion measures and benefits for organic agricultural extension. The research methodology adopted is Qualitative research consisting of Documentary research; In-Depth Interview; Participatory- Design, Co-design; and Hearing. The answer has led to formulate a model law on organic agricultural extension.

The research found that the problems of the extension of organic agriculture are unsustainable policies; conflict and overlapping the management. Promotion of organic agriculture is carried out in the form of a national committee, provincial committee, and local committee. Promotion measures are supplying markets and other related factors; setting and monitoring of product standards; establishing a network of learning centers; and tax measures. Model Law on Organic Agricultural Extension with structure of 23 Provisions, divided into 4 Chapters; Chapter 1 Committee; Chapter 2 Management; Chapter 3 Promotion and Benefits Measures; and Chapter 4 Withdrawing of Promotion and Benefits.

Research suggestion is to enact this law for implementation and to issue by laws in order to define the criteria for the farm assessment, product standards, and inspection and consideration of providing and withdrawing benefits to achieve law enforcement.
