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ABSTRACT

The objective of this research is to organize the utilization of the area to conserve archaeological sites of Wat Mahathat, Ayutthaya province by creating a specific city plan. The finding out adopted research methodology is a qualitative research consisting of documentary research; indepth interview; participatory design, co- design; and hearing.

The research findings revealed that there are five element of principles for a specific city planning; the area selection criteria for preparing a specific city planning; structural of specific city planning; committee operation; citizen's participation; and law hierarchy to implement a specific city planning. The results of the research led to formulate a model law on specific city planning for the conservation of archaeological sites. The structure of the model draft bill consisting of 30 sections, divided into 5 chapters: Chapter 1 General, Chapter 2 Committee, Chapter 3 Utilization of specific land, Chapter 4 Measures to implement a specific city planning, Chapter 5 Stipulated penalty and transitory provisions.

The research suggestions are to enact this law for the implementation, and issue byelaws on the promotion measures for the compliance of traders and citizen. The Local government Organizations issue local regulations on pattern and methodology of the participation of citizen to access information; consult; and follow up.
