ABSTRACT

The objective of the research is to establish local police in accordance with decentralized principle to reduce crime in local and ensure the safety of life, property and public order of local people. Research methodology adopted is qualitative research consisting of documentary research; in-depth interview; participatory design, co-design; and hearing, in order to draft the model law for the Establishment of Local Police.

The research found that the local police is a new model of having a local organization under a local administrative organization to act as the general police, but limit the type of offense to the extent of the authority of the local government organization. With a model law establishing the local police with a legal structure consisting of Article 29 Section is divided into 6 Chapters, Chapter 1 General Provision; Chapter 2 Local Police Policy Committee; Chapter 3 Local Administrative Organization; Chapter 4 Local Police Officers; Chapter 5 Benefits of Local Police Officers; Chapter 6 Transitional Provisions.

The research suggests to establish Local Police with authorities to prevent and suppress criminal offenses; maintain order and secure the lives and property of local people. Encourage local people to become Local Police in accordance with the established rules. Expedite the enactment of the Local Police Act to be a Police Organization at the local level.
