

THESIS TITLE	APPROPRIATE GOVERNANCE PRINCIPLES FOR THE SECRETARIAT OFFICE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
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ABSTRACT

Objectives of this research were 1) to study present conditions and problems of The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives, 2) to study appropriate concepts and theories of good governance for The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives, and 3) to develop an appropriate model of good governance principles for The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives.

Thirty samples were divided in to 4 groups by purposive sampling as follows : 1) One deputy speaker of the house of representatives, 2) 15 top and middle managements of The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives, 3) 12 first line supervisors, and 4) a group of two experts in good governance principles. In-depth interview from the above samples and hearing from some members of parliament were utilized for data collection in this research. Content analysis, mean, frequency and standard deviation were used for data analysis.

The research results were as follows : 1) Strategies and codes of ethics were the present conditions, and procurement, late parliament building construction, and unfair human resource appointment were the problems of The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives, 2) Appropriate concepts and theories concerning good governance for The Secretariat Office of The House of Representatives were found out from literature review as follows : rule of law, morality,

participation, transparency, accountability, efficiency, political neutrality, life-long learning, equity, supportive culture , equal opportunity , result-orientation , the right man for the right Job , digital world and transformational leadership. 3) After in-depth interview and hearing, the real appropriate governance principles were found as follows: morality, participation, transparency, accountability, efficiency, equity, political neutrality, the right man for the right job, rule of law and life-long learning.
