ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research is to develop a law for the establishment of an accounting division in the Central Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct Cases. The research methodology used are qualitative research consisting of documentary research; in-depth interview; Participatory design, Co-design; and Hearing.

The results of the research found that the State Audit Office of Kingdom of Thailand has duties and powers to bring corrupt government officials who misconduct in spending state money to be punished. The research, therefore, created a law to establish a new Office of the Auditor General as a Judicial form and create provisions to add an Accounting Division in the Act on the Establishment of the Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct B.E. 2559 to support the establishment.

The research suggested that the provisions that have been added to the Accounting Division in the Central Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct be proceed into the enactment process to improve the Act on the Establishment of the Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct, B.E. 2559; and to restructure the court by adding an Accounting Department to the Central Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct Cases. The Judicial Commission of the Courts of Justice shall prescribe rule on the selection of associate judges in the Accounting Division.
