ABSTRACT

This research has the objectives to formulate a model law on the protection of the native animals. The research methodology for collecting and analyzing data is qualitative research consisting of documentary research; in-depth interview; Participatory Design, Co- Design; and Hearing with descriptive analysis.

The results of the research found that Thai native animals have mutation and extinction problems that must be protected in order to be Thai unique animals by using a model law on the protection of the native animals with the legal structure of the model law consisting of Legal definitions; Committee for the protection of native animals; Protection of native animals; Application for the utilization of native animals; Authorization and licensing native animals; Protection officials; and Penalty provisions.

The research recommends that the government and relevant agencies should submit this model law to the Parliament for enactment. To publicize the importance and value of native animals to Thai people to take pride in native animals that are unique to the country.
