### **ABSTRACT**

The objective of this research is to revise and add the provisions of law on the protection of the human dignity of children. The data collection and analysis adopted is qualitative research consisting of Documentary research; In-depth interview; Participatory design, Co-Design; and Hearing.

The results of the research found that children are a vulnerable group whose rights are violated in many aspects which also inherent with violation of the human dignity of children for which the violator cannot be punished. Even if there are many child protection laws, but no provisions to protect the human dignity of children. The Child Protection Act, B.E. 2546 shall be amended and added by providing the provisions to cover protection of the child's human dignity in order to effectively prevent and solve the problem of violation of the human dignity of children. The revised and additional legal structure including definitions; elements of offence of violation of human dignity of children; measures to protect the human dignity of children; measures to rehabilitate and heal children whose dignity are violated; and penalties.

The research recommends that the Child Protection Act, B.E. 2546, which contains the revised provisions to protect the human dignity of children according to the results of this research, to be enacted as a law under the legislative process so that the human dignity of children will be protected and the violators will be punished for their offense.
