ABSTRACT

From data collected by the National Statistical Office The first survey of the elderly population in Thailand was conducted in 1994, subsequent ones in 2002, 2007, 2011, 2014, 2017 and This 2021 survey is the 7th survey. Thailand is This means that the proportion of people aged 60 years and over has increased to more than 10 percent of the entire country's population. As childhood and labor age gradually decline, then it becomes "Complete aged society" when there is more than 20 percent of the total population aged 60 years and over in the next 1-2 years (Super aged society) when there is more than 20 percent of the population aged 60 years and over. 28 percent of the total population (or the population aged 65 years and over will increase by up to 20 percent)

From the Elderly Act of 2003, there is still no provision for protecting the welfare of the elderly, including their care. Comprehensive protection and promotion of quality of life for the elderly In conducting this research The researcher wishes to conduct research on the following 5 issues.

1) The problem of receiving protection for the living conditions and income of the elderly from the government

2) The problem of receiving housing welfare protection for the elderly from the public and private sectors.

3) Problems with receiving medical care protection for the elderly according to public health laws from the public and private sectors.

4) The problem of receiving protection for the care of the elderly from descendants.

5) Problems with the protection of the elderly from the criminal justice system
